The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking quashing FIR No.174 dated 4.7.2015, registered under Sections 420/406/120-B of the Indian Penal Code and under Sections 3/ 4/ 5 of Prize Chit and Money Cir. Schemes (Banning) Act, 1978 at Police Station City Barnala, District Barnala.

2. Having argued the matter at length, learned counsel prays for withdrawal of the petition. As per prayer, petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

3. It is, however, clarified that dismissal of the present petition as withdrawn would not preclude the petitioner from raising all pleas as may be available to him in accordance with law at the appropriate stage and before the appropriate forum.
