The petitioners seek concession of pre-arrest bail in a case registered at the instance of Harpreet Kaur, alleging that on 12.11.2015, she was informed by someone that Bikkar Singh, her Uncle (Chacha) along with the petitioners and 4/5 unidentified persons had broken the lock of the ancestral house of father of the complainant and after entering the house committed theft of certain articles .

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Salwinder Singh informs that few articles alleged to have been stolen stand recovered but the petitioners are required for custodial interrogation for effecting recoveries.

I have gone through the police file and nature of the allegations. It appears to be a dispute regarding inheritance of property of Avtar Singh amongst his heirs. The petitioners being ladies have already

joined the investigation. It does not appear to be a case of custodial interrogation of the ladies to effect recovery of the household articles.

The petition is allowed. Interim order dated 20.01.2016 is hereby made absolute subject to all the conditions under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
