Seen the order dated 18.02.2016, in which it is recorded that written compromise deed dated 03.12.2015 has been executed between the contesting parties, in order to put an end to the litigation including the present one subject to the petitioners, withdrawing criminal revision pending before the Allahabad High Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that he is unable to make any statement since his clients have not contacted him to inform about it. Learned counsel for the complainant states that as and when criminal revision before the Allahabad High Court would come up, the factum about withdrawal of the revision agreed to in the written compromise
