This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr. P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 291 dated 2.5.2016 under section 498A/406 IPC registered at Police Station Sector 7, Faridabad.

Learned State counsel on instructions from the Investigating Officer submits that the petitioner joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the respondent states that the dowry articles recovered from the petitioner do not belong to her.

Keeping in view the above facts and circumstances of the case, order dated 03.06.2016 granting anticipatory bail is made absolute, subject to the condition that the petitioner shall deposit a F.D of ₹ 4 lacs before the trial Court in the name of the complainant within a period of one month. The petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when required to do so and abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. The

decision with regard to release of the above said amount will be seen by the trial Court at the final stage.

However, the petitioner is at liberty to file fresh bail bonds after presentation of the challan.

Accordingly, the petition stands disposed of.
