Quashing of the FIR No. 264 dated 24.08.2015 under Sections 498-A/323, 406, 504, 506, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Dabwali City District Sirsa (Annexure P-1) and its consequential proceedings on the basis of compromise dated 13.02.2016, is being sought.

FIR was registered on the basis of statement made by Vani Garg-respondent No.2/complainant which alleges harassment for dowry and related acts of cruelty which were allegedly meted out by the petitioners to the complainant/respondent No.2 over a period of 17 years of her matrimonial life.

Now, the matter has been amicably settled between the parties, during investigation.

In compliance of the order dated 03.06.2016, status report has been received from the Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Dabwali.

Statements of the parties have been recorded to the effect that a compromise has been affected without pressure, coercion or undue influence between the parties.

Consequently, in view of the status report and in view of the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of **Madan Mohan Abbot vs. State of Punjab 2008(2) RCR (Criminal) 429**, the law laid down by the Full Bench of this Court in the case of **Kulwinder Singh and Ors. vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052**, no useful purpose would be served in prolonging the litigation.

Accordingly, FIR No. 264 dated 24.08.2015 under Sections 498-A/323, 406, 504, 506, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Dabwali City District Sirsa (Annexure P-1), is quashed with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom qua petitioners.

The petition stands disposed of qua petitioners.
