FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Allegations against the petitioner Taranvir Singh in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in case FIR No.49 dated 01.05.2016 registered at Police Station Goraya, District Jalandhar under Sections 307/34 IPC and Sections 27/54/59 of the Arms Act, are that on 01.05.2016 a quarrel has taken place between the petitioner's side and present complainant in which the petitioner is attributed a lalkara and that his father has fired from his weapon hitting complainant Navdeep Singh on the right hand which injury of graze pellet is simple in nature.

Contentions of the learned counsel for the petitioner are that the petitioner is in custody since 03.05.2016 and that co-accused of the

petitioner Gurdeep Singh has already been allowed this relief vide orders dated 27.09.2016 of this Court and it is a case of version and cross-version as the petitioner side too has received injuries.

The factual scenario could not be displaced by learned State counsel though on behalf of the complainant Mr.Kanwaljot Singh, Advocate has sought to oppose the bail, however having regard to the fact that being a case of version and cross version, and applicability of Section 307 IPC being a debatable issue, impels this Court to allow the prayer made. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Jalandhar.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
