This is a petition under Section 438 of Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 53 dated 12.09.2015, registered under Section 323/326/506/148/149 of IPC, Police Station Srani Amant Khan, Police District Tarn Taran.

The assertion of the learned counsel for the petitioner is that one of the person from the side of the petitioner has also received grievous injury.

On 13.07.2016 the following order was passed:

“Adjourned to 15.07.2016 to enable the learned Addl. AG to verify the contents of document Annexure P-2 which is the MLR of one of the accused persons.”

On instruction from ASI Bhupinder Singh, Learned Addl. A.G accepts that the assertion of learned counsel for the petitioner is correct and states that now the police will register cross-case also.

In these circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny anticipatory bail to the present petitioner. Resultantly, the petition is allowed. In the event of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating officer subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2), Cr.P.C.

The petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer on 03.08.2016 or on any date as and when his presence is required.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
