Petitioner is alleged to have conspired with co-accused Ravinder, Naresh and Mandeep who had allegedly committed robbery of a Canter containing mobil oil besides committing the murder of its driver. The petitioner had allegedly indulged in sale of the robbed articles to co-accused Vishnu Goel who has been granted bail by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court on 12.1.2015, on the ground that he had been charged only for the offence under Section 411 IPC. Earlier application filed by the petitioner had been withdrawn on 24.9.2015.

With the assistance of counsel for the petitioner, I have gone through the charges framed against the petitioner and the evidence gathered by the investigating agency against the petitioner. The petitioner has been involved in the case on the basis of confessional statement of co-accused Mandeep to the effect that the petitioner had conspired with the other co-accused to the extent that the material robbed from oil tanker would be purchased by him.

The allegations qua the petitioner are slightly serious than the co-accused of the petitioner Vishnu Goel who has been granted concession of bail but lesser than the offence alleged to have been committed by Mandeep along with Ravinder and Naresh. No recovery is alleged to have been effected from the petitioner.

Taking into consideration the fact that petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 16.2.2015, he can be granted the concession of regular bail.

The petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
