FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

The allegations against the petitioner in this regular bail application under Section 439 Cr.P.C are that on 29.4.2015 the petitioner along with his co-accused/non-applicant riding on Pulsar motorcycle were accosted by the police and fired in the air. The contentions of the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is in custody for more than 01 year and 04 months and that it is a non-injury case are conceded to by the learned State counsel who does not disputes the period of incarceration and recovery of country made pistol .315 from the petitioner.

Keeping in view the substantive incarceration period and that the trial is not likely to be concluded in near future and no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars, without

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adverting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition for grant of regular bail is allowed. Petitioner be admitted to bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
