FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.(ORAL)

Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C.
seeking grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.250
dated 14.12.2015 registered at Police Station Loharu, Distt. Bhiwani
under Sections 147/148/323/452/506 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in
compliance of the previous orders passed by this Court, the petitioner
has joined investigations which is not controverted by learned State
counsel on instructions from ASI Rohtash, Police Station Loharu,
District Bhiwani who submits that the petitioner is no longer required
for further investigation and nothing is to be recovered from him and
that he has no objection if the interim order is made absolute.

In view of this fact and that evidently it is a case of personal vendetta and rivalry between the two sides and in the light of orders passed earlier, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 02.06.2016 is made absolute till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Petitioner shall furnish an undertaking that he shall abide by the conditions specified under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
