Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr. P.C.') seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.432 dated 23.11.2014, registered under Sections 21, 61, 85 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substance Act, 1985 (for short 'NDPS Act') at Police Station Civil Lines, Amritsar.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Rajni Gupta, Addl. AG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

It is not in dispute that the petitioner was on regular bail granted by the trial Judge for a period of six months in the above said FIR. He made a default on 08.09.2015 and remained absent before the trial Court resulting into cancellation of his bail and issuance of non-bailable warrants.

Learned State counsel submits that the proceedings as

proclaimed offender were already on and petitioner has to appear before the trial Court as a proclaimed offender on 06.07.2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that hereafter, petitioner would not make any default in regular appearance before the trial Court and would accordingly, file an affidavit before the trial Judge.

Statement is accepted.

In view of the above, I make the following order:-

(1) The petitioner shall continue to be on bail that was granted to him by the trial Judge on the same terms and conditions, and further submit an undertaking before the trial Court that he shall attend the trial Court on regular basis. On 06.07.2016, the petitioner shall also furnish fresh bonds before the trial Court.
