Petitioner, in the capacity as Clerk in the office of District Transport Officer, Faridkot, is alleged to have connived with District Transport Officer Nachhattar Singh Brar and committed misconduct by allotting fancy numbers in open auction to the people who did not even participate in the auction.

Co-accused of the petitioner Nachhattar Singh Brar has been granted concession of pre-arrest bail by this Court on 15.09.2016 in CRM-M-20823-2016.

Learned State counsel informs that none of the officer of the concerned department, has approached her to contest the present petition.

Taking into consideration the above said circumstances and drawing a parity with the co-accused, the petition is allowed. Interim order dated 22.07.2016 is hereby made absolute. It is ordered that in case of arrest of petitioner, he will be released on bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer subject to the conditions that the petitioner will not tamper

with the evidence or hamper the investigation in any manner and will also cooperate with the investigating agency and facilitate the tracing of the documents and files regarding which he has got knowledge.

This order will not in any manner prejudice the right of the prosecution agency to effect recovery in accordance with law.
