By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in a case FIR No.62, dated 04.04.2016, registered under Sections 306 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'the IPC'), at Police Station Chandimandir, District Panchkula.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in pursuance of the order dated 03.06.2016, the petitioner has joined the investigation. He further states that no offence of any abetment is made out against the petitioner.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the

investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 03.06.2016, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
