This is a petition for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.522 dated 02.10.2015 registered under Sections 406/420/408/120-B IPC at P.S. Sarai Khawaja, District Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the main accused from the bank side was one manager Dheeraj Kumar who had actually helped the main accused and he has been dismissed from service but lesser punishment has been imposed upon the petitioner. Learned counsel for the petitioner further states that he has joined the investigation.

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Learned Addl. A.G on instructions from ASI Manoj Kumar has accepted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and no more required for custodial interrogation.

In these circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Resultantly, the petition is allowed. The interim order dated 03.06.2016 is made absolute.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
