This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.124 dated 17.06.2015, registered under Sections 148, 149, 186, 189, 188, 353, 379, 307 IPC and Sections 25/54 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Hasanpur, District Palwal.

Reply filed by way of affidavit of Bhagat Ram, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Hodal is taken on record. Copy has been supplied.

The allegations are that the police received a secret information that some persons are coming with stolen sand in three tractor trolleys and when police tried to place naka those tractor drivers alongwith the petitioner and other co-accused came in car and tried to run over the police officials and were able to take away those three sand filled trolleys.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that this is a no injury case and the allegations levelled are absolutely not made out at all.

Learned Additional Advocate General on instructions from ASI Vinod Kumar has accepted the fact that this is a no injury case.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case.

Petition is allowed. In the event of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on bail by the Investigating Officer subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petitioner is directed to appear before the investigating officer on 19.08.2016 and on any other date as and when his presence is required. In case the petitioner does not appear before the investigating

have been dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
