By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioners have sought anticipatory bail in a case FIR No.73, dated 16.05.2013, registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'the IPC'), at Police Station Makhu, Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

The learned counsel for the petitioners contends that in pursuance of the order dated 03.06.2016, the petitioners have joined the investigation. He further states that a civil suit regarding the authenticity of the Will in question has already been filed by the complainant and co-accused, Paramjit Kaur and Manpreet Singh, who already granted benefit of bail.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 03.06.2016, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
