The petitioners seek quashing of FIR No. 14 dated 12.02.2016, on the basis of the compromise. The FIR was registered at the instance of respondent No. 2, namely Bhupinder Singh, alleging that the petitioners had constituted an unlawful assembly and committed theft in his house.

The matter has been compromised between the parties. They were directed to appear before the trial Court and get their statements recorded.

A report has been received to the effect that the matter has been compromised amicably between the parties.

Following the Full Bench judgment of this Court in

Kulwinder Singh and others v. State of Punjab and another, 2007 (3)

RCR (Criminal) 1052, the petition is allowed. FIR No. 14 dated 12.02.2016, under Sections 148, 149, 379, 427 and 506 I.P.C., and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Haibowal, Ludhiana, and all the consequential proceedings emanating therefrom, are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise
