By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in FIR No.413 dated 12.08.2010, registered under Sections 353, 224, 225 and 186 IPC, at Police Station Sadar, Patiala.

On 03.06.2016, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Petitioner escaped alongwith Bhupinder Singh from police custody after their arrest on August 12, 2010 as per the complaint of ASI Karnail Singh.

It is contended that all the offences are bailable except for offence under Section 353 IPC.

Notice to Advocate General, Punjab, for August 29, 2016.

Meanwhile, an interim direction is issued that the

petitioner will join investigation on June 11, 2016, June 25,2016 and August 6, 2016 or any other date as required by the investigating officer and in case of his doing so, he will be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer.”

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

The learned State counsel, on instructions submits that in pursuance of the order dated 03.06.2016, the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 03.06.2016, is made absolute, subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
