Therefore, the prayer has been made for directing the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Jagraon, to decide the complaint in a time bound manner.

In these circumstances, the learned Sessions Judge, Ludhiana, is directed to look into the matter and since the complaint is 10 years old and trial is going on, therefore, he shall ensure that the proper directions are issued on the administrative side to the concerned learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Jagraon, to expedite the trial.
