Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for issuance of a direction to respondent No.2 to investigate the matter against the private respondents No.5 and 6 and to take legal action.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that for the relief claimed in the present petition, the petitioners have already approached respondents No.2 and 3 by way of complaints dated 1.12.2015 and 5.4.2016 (Annexures P-1 and P-2 respectively), but no action thereon has been taken by the police so far.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only at this stage.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Gurinderjit Singh, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is directed to hand over requisite number of complete copies of the paper book to learned State counsel during course of the day.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur to take note of the contents of complaints dated 1.12.2015 and 5.4.2016 (Annexures P-1 and P-2 respectively) and to act in accordance with law.
