Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for issuance of a direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and her son.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that despite there being no case against the petitioner or her son, she is being called by the police time and gain. He further contends that the petitioner has already approached respondent No.2 seeking redressal of her grievances, but no action has been taken by the police.
