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KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

Petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.129, dated 01.09.2012, under Sections 393, 506 and 454 read with Section 34 IPC, registered at Police Station City Khanna.

From the contents of FIR, it comes out that all the three petitioners tried to rob the complainant during the day time by entering the house on the pretext of delivering the marriage card. However, when the complainant raised alarm, they ran away.

It is a serious crime, which affects the law and order and the safety of the senior citizens. Thus, there is no ground to quash the FIR in question.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
