FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners Narinder Singh Gill and Davinder Kaur in case registered by way of FIR No.58 dated 27.04.2016 at Police Station Sadar Ludhiana under Sections 294/427/452/511/506/34 IPC and Section 3 of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of the orders of interim bail dated 03.06.2016 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined investigations which is not controverted by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Yogeshwar Sharma, Police Station Sadar Ludhiana who submits that the petitioners are no longer required for further investigation and nothing is

to be recovered from them and that he has no objection if the interim order is made absolute.

In view of what has been stated above and in the light of orders passed earlier, the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 03.06.2016 is made absolute on the same terms and conditions till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, petitioners will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
