This is a petition for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner under
Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.38 dated 25.04.2016 registered under
Sections 420, 120-B IPC at P.S. Khanauri, Sangrur.

As per the allegations, the petitioner has surrendered money from a
lot of people under the Kitty Scheme.

Learned DAG has argued that originally the complaint was filed by only four persons but now there are many more persons joined, who made similar complaints.

Learned counsel for the complainant has also placed on record CD in which brother of the petitioner stated to be making incriminating statement.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the correctness of the CD has not yet been established.

Be that it may so, in view of the nature of the allegation, I deem it appropriate to dismiss the petition.

Petition stands dismissed.
