Reply by way of affidavit of Ajeet Singh, HPS, Assistant
Commissioner of Police, Manesar on behalf of respondent No.1-
State has been filed in Court and same is taken on record.

2. This petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the
Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No. 825, dated
December 31, 2015, under Sections 147/149/323/506/307 of IPC,
registered at Police Station Manesar, Distt. Gurgaon (**Annexure P-1**)
along with all consequential proceedings arising out of the same on
the basis of compromise (**Annexure P-2**).

3. In compliance of order dated January 20, 2016, statement of the parties have been recorded by the trial Court. Report of learned Civil Judge, Junior Division, Gurgaon, has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that parties have arrived at compromise with their free consent from any quarter. Even otherwise, matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

4. In view of the above, I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

5. Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and FIR No. 825, dated December 31, 2015, under Sections 147/149/323/506/307 of IPC, registered at Police Station Manesar, Distt. Gurgaon and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioners.
