This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to ensure the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to falsely implicate them and their family members in any false criminal case at the behest of private respondent Nos.4 and 5, their relatives and friends.

Petitioner Nos.2 and 3 are stated to have contracted marriage on 31.05.2016 though both of them are minors.

Even on the last date, none had caused representation on behalf of the petitioners. It appears that the petitioners have lost interest in the matter.

The learned State counsel states that as per the information

collected by the State, the petitioners are involved in FIR No.30 dated 20.05.2016 registered under Sections 366-A and 504 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'IPC') read with Section 34 IPC, at Police Station Basnai, Bihar.

In view of above, the present petition is dismissed.
