Petitioner seeks concession of regular bail in a case registered at the instance of Gurbhej Singh alleging that the petitioner was one of the members of unlawful assembly consisting of 10-11 people who were armed with various weapons.

Complainant Gurbhej Singh appeared as a witness on oath. I have gone through his statement. He has stated that the petitioner was present armed with 'dangs' along with Balbir Singh and threatened the complainant side to teach a lesson for getting panchayati land vacated. He along with his other co-accused Joga Singh, Iqbal Singh, Sukhdev Singh has been attributed role of having raise 'lalkara' with weapons in their hands.

It is not out of place to mention here that application under Section 319 Cr.P.C filed by complainant Gurbhej Singh to summon additional accused Dalip Singh and Lakhwinder Singh, has been allowed.

In view of petitioner having not been attributed any specific injury, taking into consideration the period of detention suffered by him, he can be granted the concession of bail.

The petition is allowed. Petitioner Sukhdev Singh is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to the conditions that he will not tamper with the evidence and will not in any manner make any attempt to threaten the witnesses directly or indirectly and will not commit similar offence of which he is accused of, during the entire period of trial.
