Learned State counsel points out that during the pendency of this petition, charges have been framed by the court and case has now come up for recording prosecution evidence.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to raise all the pleas before the trial court at the appropriate stage. He, however, prays that the personal appearance of the petitioner, who is 35 years woman and is suffering from serious disease, before the trial court may be exempted.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as prayed for. In case the petitioner moves an application for exemption of her personal appearance, same shall be considered by the trial court in accordance with law. The trial court may exempt the personal appearance of the petitioner on such terms & conditions, as it deems proper to impose. The petitioner may be allowed to appear through their counsel except on the dates her presence is necessary.
