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**A. B. CHAUDHARI, J. (ORAL)**

The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.282 dated 11.11.2015 registered under Sections 66C and 66D of Information Technology Act, 2000 at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Counsel for the petitioner as well as complainant jointly state that the compromise in respect of the instant FIR has been arrived at between the parties.

There is order dated 06.06.2016 made by this Court for recording the statement of the parties. Perused the report furnished by the concerned JMIC about the genuineness of the compromise between the parties. The dispute appears to be matrimonial.

In view of the finding recorded by the JMIC, Dasuya that the compromise is indeed genuine and without any coercion and threat, there

should be no difficulty in accepting the compromise and quashing the FIR. In that view of the matter I make the following order:

**ORDER**

- (i) The CRL. MISC. No.M-20440 OF 2016 is allowed.
- (ii) The FIR No.282 dated 11.11.2015 registered under Sections 66C and 66D of Information Technology Act, 2000 at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur, is quashed along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.
