JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of directions to the respondents No. 2 to 5 to register an FIR and to take appropriate action on complaint/application (Annexure P-3) as well to conduct fair and impartial investigation of the case by deputing a senior police officer.

2. It has been *inter-alia* contended by learned counsel for the petitioner though a representation (Annexure P-3) was moved but till date no action has been taken on the said representation. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.4 to decide the representation (Annexure P-3) within a stipulated period.

3. Notice of motion.

4. At the asking of Court, Ms. Neelam Kashyap, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State of Haryana. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

5. The present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4-Superintendent of Police, Kaithal to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation (Annexure P-3) and if some substance is found, to take an appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of certified copy of this order.
