This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to immediately recover the British Passport, 3000 pounds, OCI, return ticket, jewellery of the petitioner from private respondents, who had stolen the same on 24.12.2015 with a view to hold up the petitioner in India. With further prayer to take appropriate legal action against the private respondents for beating the petitioner and causing injuries with sharp edged weapon.

Notice to respondents No.1 to 3.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Rajpreet Singh Sidhu, AAG, Punjab, has accepted notice on behalf of respondents-State. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he feels satisfied in case direction is given to respondent No.2 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in her representation dated 06.01.2016 (Annexure P-2).

The instant petition is disposed of with directions to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural) Jalandhar, Punjab to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in her representation dated 06.01.2016 (Annexure P-2) and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
