The instant petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, has been filed with a prayer to issue direction to respondent Nos.1 to 3, for taking action against respondent Nos.4 and 5, on the basis of representation dated 23.05.2016.

In response to order dated 24.10.2016, issuing notice of motion, reply has been filed on behalf of the State. It is evident from the reply that acting on the representation moved by the petitioner, FIR No.343 dated 26.06.2016, under Sections 384 and 506 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, has been registered at Police Station City, Sonipat, against respondent Nos.4 and 5. Pursuant to the registration of the FIR, respondent Nos.4 and 5 were arrested and subsequently released on bail.
