1. Whether the Reporters of local newspaper may be allowed to see the judgment ?

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KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to respondent No. 3 i.e. Station House Officer, Women Cell, Sector-17, Chandigarh, not to harass and humiliate the petitioner by calling him at the Women Cell, Sector-17, Chandigarh, without complying with the provisions of Section 160 Cr.P.C. Further prayer has been made to transfer the investigation/inquiry to some other district.

The learned counsel contends that a complaint has been filed against the present petitioner and his family members by his wife. Respondent No. 6-Ravinder Singh, who happens to be a Sub Inspector in the Chandigarh Police, is interfering in the investigation and harassing them. The prayer is for transfer of the investigation

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to some other police officer.

In view of the matter, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to file an appropriate application before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh, who shall assure that the inquiry is done by a person, who is not under the influence of Sub Inspector Ravinder Singh (respondent No. 6).

Disposed of.
