A.B. Chaudhari, J. (Oral):-

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties. In FIR No.73 dated 16.02.2015, registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station City Fatehabad, the petitioner is being prosecuted. Learned counsel for the complainant-Mr. Karan Garg, makes a statement that the property in respect of which the FIR was lodged was sold out. The petitioner has compensated the respondent by paying money. Be that as it may, since the parties want to compound/compromise, there is no point in continuing the prosecution.

In the result, FIR No.73 dated 16.02.2015, registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station City Fatehabad along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom is quashed.
