KULDIP SINGH, J (ORAL)

Present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No. 18 dated 11.01.2013 (Annexure-P-1) registered under Sections 324/326/452/ 427 of the IPC at Police Station Sadar Jalandhar, District Jalandhar and subsequent proceedings arising out of aforementioned FIR on the basis of compromise.

Report of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jalandhar has been received.

The learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jalandhar, after recording the statement of the complainant as well as the accused persons, has reported that the parties have compromised the matter without any pressure, undue influence and coercion from any side.

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In view of the fact that the parties have compromised the matter, the FIR No. 18 dated 11.01.2013 registered under Sections 324/326/452/ 427 of the IPC at Police Station Sadar Jalandhar, District Jalandhar, and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, stand quashed.
