Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the matter has been settled amicably between the parties.

Respondent No. 4 Roop Lal S/o Sarwan Ram father of petitioner No. 1 along with his counsel Shri L.S.Lakhanpal, is present in Court and submits that he has no objection to the marriage contracted by the petitioners between themselves on 25.05.2016 and they face no danger to their life and liberty from him or his family members. Father of petitioner No. 2, Gopal Chand is also present in Court and submits that he has no objection to the solemnization of marriage between the petitioners and he would take care of their well being.

Keeping in view the above submissions, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks to withdraw this petition, however, with liberty to approach respondent No. 2, if at all any kind of apprehension is felt by the petitioners in respect to their life and liberty on account of their marriage

against the wishes of the parents of petitioner No. 1.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid. In case any such representation is submitted to respondent No. 2, necessary action as may be required be taken after due consideration of the representation.

It is however, made clear that this order shall have no effect on the validity of the alleged marriage of the petitioners.
