Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has been in custody for about one month and even the prime accused in the case has already been granted bail by this Court, vide order dated 07.06.2016, passed in CRM-M-18047 of 2016. A copy of the same has been produced in Court today. He further submits that the petitioner is in judicial custody and he being a lab technician, permanently resident of Hansi, District Hisar, he is not likely to abscond, as he also has landed property in his name.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, does not deny the above.

In view of the fact that the prime accused has been enlarged on bail, the same concession is ordered to be granted to the petitioner also, subject to his providing two sureties in reasonably heavy amounts, to the satisfaction of the learned CJM/ Duty Magistrate, Hisar.
