The petitioner seeks quashing of Complaint No 89/2 of 2014/2015, titled as Bal Kishan Versus Surender Saharan, filed against him under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881, pending in the Court of the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Sirsa. He has also challenged the summoning order dated 4.3.2015 (Annexure-P-2), passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Sirsa.

In these circumstances, the petitioner is relegated to avail the remedy of revision before the Sessions Court against the summoning order. The revision, if so filed, shall be disposed of on merits, notwithstanding the point of limitation.
