Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not intend to file reply to the application and has no objection is the same is allowed.

CRM-M-20690 of 2016

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Shamsheer Singh, Police Station, Mulepur, District Fatehgarh Sahib submits that in compliance of order dated 09.06.2016 of this Court the petitioner has joined the investigations and that nothing is to be recovered from him and has no objection if the interim orders are made absolute.

At this stage Mrs. Daljit Kaur, Advocate has put in

appearance on behalf of the complainant and tried to oppose the grant of bail on the ground that Rs.3 Crores has been duped by the petitioner from the complainant side qua this land in question.

Appreciating the submissions, it is the admitted stand of the complainant's counsel as well that the land in question is a *shamlat* land owned by the village Panchayat and there is no allegation against the petitioner for having misrepresented or acted in a fraudulent manner to hide the truth as to the status of the property in question together with the principle of “*buyer beware*” and that the stand of the State certainly shows that there is no case for custodial interrogation of the petitioner.

In view thereof *ad interim* orders dated 09.06.2016 passed by this Court are made absolute.

The petition stands disposed off.
