Petitioner seeks concession of regular bail in a case of homicide of Narender Kaur. As per the allegations of complainant Kulwant Rai, the petitioner alongwith Surjit Singh (husband of the deceased) had assaulted and murdered her and hanged the dead body on the ceiling fan.

So far as the petitioner is concerned, the only allegation against him in context to Section 201 IPC is of having facilitated the hanging of the dead body. The petitioner has been in custody since 16.11.2015. Challan has already been presented.

Petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bond/surety bond to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

This order is not meant to be treated as a precedent for the co-accused.
