AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in cross case bearing DDR No.26 dated 12.12.2014, registered under Sections 302, 307, 324, 452, 427,

148, 149 and Sections 25, 27 of the Arms Act, in case FIR No.261 dated

12.12.2014 registered under Sections 302, 307, 324, 452, 427, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25, 27 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Lopoke, Amritsar Rural, District Amritsar.

As per the FIR, the petitioner was armed with a gandasi but no injury was attributed to him and this is a case where there is also cross version and people have died on both sides. The similarly situated accused also filed petitions for regular bail bearing CRM-M No.16948 of 2016 for the bail of Gurbax Singh and CRM-M No.16975 of 2016 for the bail of Dilbagh Singh @ Maru and they both got regular bail by order dated 25.05.2016. It was specifically mentioned in the said order that no injury/overt act/direct role had been attributed to Dilbagh Singh. The investigating officer has accepted that even as against the petitioner no injury is attributed.

In the circumstances, I see no reason to take a different view. Keeping in view the above facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
