This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.81 dated 27.05.2012 registered under Section 18 of NDPS Act, at Police Station Canal Colony, Bathinda, District Bathinda.

The case against the petitioner is that 10 kilograms of opium was recovered from him.

Learned DAG, on instructions from HC Balwinder Singh,

states that status report has not been filed in pursuance of the last order

and only one prosecution witness remains to be examined by the prosecution and it would be appropriate to put a time cap on the trial than release the petitioner on bail in view of his antecedents. On instructions from the investigating officer he states that the prosecution will lead its entire evidence by 30.11.2016(subject to the accused not obstructing the same).

I find this to be a very fair statement.

Resultantly it is directed that in case the prosecution does not conclude its entire evidence by 30.11.2016 (subject to the accused not obstructing the same), the trial Court shall release the petitioner on bail to its satisfaction.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the Civil Misc.

Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
