Heard learned counsel for the rival parties and perused the FIR in question namely FIR No. 10 dated 11.1.2016 registered under Sections 379/379A/379B Indian Penal Code at Police Station Kotwali, Faridkot, District Faridkot.

Admittedly, the challan has been filed. It is not disputed that the petitioners have committed first offence and they were arrested on 11.1.2016 and have been in jail since then. Looking at the age of the petitioners as between 20 to 25 years, in my opinion, the trial may take long time and no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioners in jail till the completion of the trial.

Both the petitioners undertake to file an affidavit and that of their respective fathers that they would not commit such an offence in future.

In that view of the matter, I am inclined to grant bail. The petitioners are ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the concerned Trial Court.

Both the petitioners would file their own affidavits and also of their father that they will not commit such an offence in future.
