The prayer in this present petition filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C is for quashing of FIR No. 265 dated 09.10.2014 (*Annexure P-1*) registered under Sections 307, 148, 149 of IPC at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur alongwith all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise (*Annexure P-3*).

The report of the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Dasuya has been received wherein it has been reported that the statements of the complainant and accused have been recorded and compromise has been effected between the parties. It is further reported that the said compromise is voluntary and is without any coercion, pressure or undue influence.

In this case, the allegations are that husband tried to strangulate his wife Amandeep Kaur. On the basis of compromise, the police has presented the cancellation report which was further rejected by the Illaqa Magistrate.

Learned counsel for the petitioner stated that the husband and wife are now living together and that they have amicably settled their dispute.

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In view of the fact that the dispute between husband and wife has been amicably settled, FIR No. 265 dated 09.10.2014 (*Annexure P-1*) registered against all the accused named in the said FIR, under Sections 307, 452, 148, 149 of IPC at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur stands quashed alongwith all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed.
