LISA GILL, J.

Present petition has been filed by the petitioners for protection of their life and liberty as they apprehend danger at the hands of respondents No. 6 to 8 because they have contracted marriage between themselves on 06.06.2016 against the wishes of the said respondents.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Ankur Jain, AAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 5.

Mr. Lajpat Sharma, Advocate appears on behalf of respondents No. 6 to 8.

It is submitted that petitioner No. 1's parents i.e. respondents No. 6 and 7 have no objection to the marriage between the parties and there is no question of any threat to their life and liberty at their hands or that of respondent No. 8. Affidavits dated 10.06.2016 are taken on record.

In view of the stand taken by respondents No. 6 to 8, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 3 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar to look into any subsequent representation, if any, made by the petitioners in case any kind of threat is apprehended by the petitioners to the life and liberty on account of marriage being solemnised by them against the wishes of respondents No. 6 to 8.
