At this stage, Mr. Sarvesh K. Gupta, Advocate puts in appearance along with private respondents No.4 and 5 and opposes the marriage of the petitioners.

Though the learned counsel representing the private respondents No.4 and 5 has tried to oppose the relationship between the petitioners, however in the light of contentions of learned counsel for the petitioners that they are seeking the only relief of protection to their lives and personal liberty which is a mandate of law, the petition stands disposed off with direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide

the representation of the petitioners (Annexure P5) within the framework of law. Meanwhile, in case any instance of threat is brought to the notice of the police by the petitioners, they will act into it expeditiously in accordance with law.
