The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to take action against respondents No.4 to 6 as the life of the petitioner is in danger at their hands.

Notice of motion was issued on 16.06.2015. In response thereto, separate replies on behalf of State as well as on behalf of respondents No.4 to 6 have already been filed which are on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was being harassed by respondents No.4 to 6 and a written complaint was also made against them but no action was taken by the police authorities.

Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner was called for recording of her statement but she never came forward for getting her statement recorded. Moreover, the petitioner was not found at the address given in the complaint.

Learned counsel for respondents No.4 to 6 submits that no threat was given to the petitioner and the present petition is the counter-blast of the complaint filed against her. Learned counsel also undertakes not to give any threat to the petitioner in future.

Keeping in view the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties, nothing survives in the present petition.

However, in case, the petitioner is aggrieved by any subsequent act on the part of the respondents, she is at liberty to move representation/complaint against them to the concerned police authority.

Disposed of accordingly.
