AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

On 13.06.2016 the following order was passed:-

“The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.188 dated 11.09.2012, under Sections 307, 148, 149, 120-B of Indian Penal Code and

Section 27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

Counsel would submit that the petitioner was arrested and thereafter granted benefit of regular bail by this Court in the light of order dated 10.07.2013 passed in CRM No.M-12177 of 2013. However, on account of non-appearance before the trial Court on 18.04.2016, the concession of bail has been cancelled and his bail bonds have been forfeited. It is the categorical contention raised by the counsel that the trial proceedings have at no stage been stalled at the instance of the present petitioner and the intent of the petitioner was not to evade trial proceedings.

Notice of motion, returnable for 20.09.2016.

In the meanwhile, it is directed that in case the petitioner duly appears before the trial Court on the date already fixed i.e. 07.07.2016, he would be granted interim bail subject to satisfaction of the trial Court. ”

Learned Additional Advocate General states that pursuant to order dated 13.06.2016 the petitioner has duly appeared before the trial Court and has been granted interim bail.

In this view of the matter, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Petition is allowed. Interim bail granted by the trial Court is made absolute.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
