This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise.

FIR was lodged by one Priya Sehgal. She stated that she was waiting for Auto Rickshaw on the main road near Pamme Di Pulli, Amritsar. At that time a person on a motor cycle came and snatched the purse which she was holding in her hand. The purse contained some cash and mobile phone. He thereafter fled from the spot.

Keeping in view nature of the allegations, FIR cannot be quashed on the basis of compromise. It is not an offence which is private in nature. It is an offence against the Society. Investigation in such matters has to be taken to its logical end.

Dismissed.
