AMIT RAWAL, J. (Oral)

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that originally FIR was registered under Section 309 IPC against the deceased namely Asha Rani. Later on statement of Mr. Rajesh Kumar suffered after 10 days and found that petitioner had been instigating and harassing the deceased and, therefore, she took such extreme step. Thereafter, Section 306 has been added.

The petitioner is stated to be incarcerated since 21.10.2015.

Mr. T.N. Sarup, Addl. A.G. Punjab submits that challan has already been presented and two witnesses out of 10, has been examined.

In view of the fact that trial may take sometime, I deem it appropriate to grant him bail and accordingly, petitioner is ordered to be

released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Jalandhar.

The present criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed with
aforementioned direction.
